## **Privatisation Options:**

The Federal Executive Council (FEC), the highest ruling body of the Federal Republic of Nigeria on May  $21^{\rm st}$  2003 took the decision to liquidate the national carrier. The FEC directed the National Council on Privatisation (NCP) and its Secretariat the Bureau of Public Enterprises (BPE) to commence the process of liquidation.

Accordingly, the resolution for winding up petition has been filed and the Court order has been obtained.

The court ordered the appointment of Mr. Ade Barbington Ashaye as the provisional liquidator of NAL pending the determination of the main petition.

The court has approved the process of winding up of NAL and also the court orders have been registered with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC)
