



# Peterborough Municipal Airport | **CYPO**

The Peterborough Municipal Airport has the longest paved, lighted runway between Ottawa and Toronto. This full-service facility caters to both business and general aviation by offering complete pilot, passenger and aircraft services.



Our 5,000 ft. runway is equipped with lighting and the Precision Approach Path Indicator (PAPI) system which provides reliable and safe approach assistance to aircraft. Our terminal operations feature Customs pre-clearance using CANPASS and the Springville Café serving local and transient traffic. Catering available on request.

General aviation aircraft traffic plays a very important role at the Airport. With approximately 20,000 - 30,000 aircraft movements per year, there are many recreational and commercial users. Daily traffic includes corporate jets, medical flights, flight school activity and cargo shipments. Numerous freight aircraft utilize the Peterborough Airport with available load capacity; freight handling, forklift service and trucking.

There are no aircraft noise restrictions, slot time requirements or operating hour curfews for freight and passenger flights.

This well-diversified airport can facilitate the needs of all aircraft. Airport services include piston and turbine maintenance, pressurized aircraft maintenance, radio repair facility, turbine overhaul facility, DAR, interior and exterior refinishing, aircraft engineering, aircraft parts suppliers, flight training, charters and Transport Canada Satellite Office.
