Mike Fitzpatrick Scholarships

The Mike Fitzpatrick Scholarships are designed to support young players in their education and training while they are aspiring to an AFL career. The program has been developed in conjunction with the AFLPA Player Development Program and reinforces the association's commitment to the future player education and welfare of AFL players.

The scholarships are named after Mike Fitzpatrick in recognition of his outstanding efforts and achievement to combine football with academic excellence. Mike took leave from professional football in 1975 and left Australia to study a Rhodes scholarship at Oxford, Upon completion of his studies, Mike reioined the Carlton Football Club and was captain from 1980 to 1983. As well as being an AFL Commissioner, Mike is founder and managing director of Hastings Funds Management Limited. He was formerly a director with CS First Boston, a member of the Melbourne Park Tennis Centre Trust, a director of the Carlton Football Club, Chairman of the Australian Sports Commission and a Vice President of the then VFL Players' Association in the early 1980s.

Criteria

- Scholarships are available to players who have turned 15 but not attained the age of 17 by 30 June in the year the scholarship is awarded
- The scholarship is for the period from 1 January to 31 December of the awarded year
- The player must remain in secondary school or its equivalent for the period of the grant

The grant has been given to the player to assist him to meet his educational commitments whilst developing as a footballer. The grant funding can be used to directly pay for the education of a player or to reimburse him or his family for these expenses.
