## Instruction on Philosophy and Use of the Judge Review Form

Judge review forms are a means to provide lasting reminders of constructive feedback to your peers. The judge program is a peer-review community based on mentorship between its members. The form should be the end-result of your mentorship with each other after an event, not the first feedback a judge hears from you.

Mentorship and feedback should occur at the end of the day of an event. Judges should sit with each other and provide each-other with feedback on their strengths and weaknesses face-to-face whenever possible. At this time the review form should be used to take \_notes\_ on the feedback you are presenting in person. After you return home use these notes to fill out a complete form electronically in the Judge Center <u>http://judge.wizards.com</u>.

If you have feedback on a judge and \_strongly\_ believe you need to remain anonymous in providing that feedback then take notes during the event and write the summary without your information included and send the form to me directly via email(please include the name of the judge reviewed in the subject line for archiving purposes) and I will filter and pass along any constructive criticisms.
