



First-Time Pass and Shot

To perform a first-time pass, press immediately before receiving the ball. You will receive the ball then pass it without it coming to rest. To perform a first-time shot, press immediately before receiving the ball. You will receive and shoot without the ball coming to rest.

Ball Swerve

To change the direction of a ball in mid-air, press Left/Right while the ball is in flight.
