Grinnell Library staff would like to thank Town of Wappinger voters who recently approved a

funding increase for the Library.

Here are some exciting service improvements to look for in 2009:

- 1. The Library will be open for an outreach programs. additional 210 hours per year!
- 2. The Homework Mentor Program, which provides free homework assistance to K-12 students will expand from its current 2 days per week to 5 days per week.
- 3. Our materials budget for popular high demand items like DVD movies and Books on CD will increase. More of these items will be available to our community.

- 4. We will improve staffing at the Library's reference desk.
- 5. We will maintain funding for popular programs like the Library's Summer Reading Program, Family Game Nights, Teen Anime/Manga Club, Computer Tutor and senior outreach programs.
