A Visit Is Worth a **Thousand Brochures**

A college can seem to have everything you and your student are looking for and still not be the right fit. In an era when promotions hit your mailbox every day and your inbox fills with emails describing the latest programs available at the universities on your teen's "list," it can be a difficult task to help your student determine the right path. Although new social media outlets and websites are available to help with the college decision, one way of determining the right college fit has remained a consistent source of excellent information-the campus visit.

What can you gain from a campus visit?

New information sources

On a campus visit, you will often have the opportunity to connect with professors and current students from your teen's area of academic interest. These individuals experience the classroom environment every day and can give you tremendous insight into what your student can expect. You can also meet with representatives from financial aid. housing, and student life who can provide great information about their respective areas. A campus visit can result in information overload, so don't be afraid to ask for contact information and to take notes to reference after your visit. Although your student may be embarrassed by your attention to detail, they'll probably appreciate it later.

The campus atmosphere

Descriptions in glossy brochures and on websites can never fully capture the true campus atmosphere. You can read that a campus is a small oasis in the middle of a large metropolitan




