Housing

You can find information on our website about council housing and housing associations. There is also information about supported housing, along with advice for private tenants and landlords.

If you are homeless or threatened with homelessness our site has information about our Leeds Housing Options Service. This service can provide you with help and advice if you are in housing need.

If you are a council tenant, three Arm's Length Management Organisations (or ALMOs) manage council housing in Leeds. The ALMOs are responsible for

- Your local housing office
- Collecting rent
- Managing our council estates
- Day-to-day repairs
- letting council homes
- The modernisation and improvement of council homes.

We have links on our site to all three ALMOs.

On our site you will find a link to the Leeds Homes website where there is useful advice about how to apply for council housing. You can also use this site to search for council and housing association properties that are available for rent.

If you have financial problems, due to working reduced hours, or if you no longer work our site has advice about claiming Housing Benefit. The policy applies to people renting a private or council property.
