ViCAP ALERT: Homicide

The Garfield County Sheriff's Office (western Colorado) is investigating the discovery of a dismembered body that was found on private property adjacent to Garfield County Road 137, also known as Canyon Creek Road, which is located approximately parallel to the 109 mile mark of Interstate 70 (I-70). The area of the discovery is located on the north side of the interstate and is approximately five (5) miles west of the City of Glenwood Springs, CO.

A post-mortem exam was conducted on June 13, 2009. The exam revealed the body was that of an adult Caucasian female with brown hair and blonde highlights. The female victim had tattoos and dental work. Not all of the remains have been recovered at this point.

Subsequently, the body has been positively identified through fingerprint comparison as 38 year old Janine Ann Johler of Aurora CO (front range area/metro Denver). Janine Ann Johler had been reported to the Aurora Police Department by her family as a missing person on May 7th, 2009.

The Garfield County Sheriff's Office is working in conjunction with the Aurora Police Department, other Denver metro law enforcement agencies, the Colorado Bureau of Investigation and the FBI in continuance of this investigation.

Garfield County Crime Stoppers is searching for information that could lead to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons involved in the murder of Janine Johler.
