

Duke University Press now offers an expanded collection of journals in the humanities and social sciences. Because the number of titles published by Duke is expected to grow from year to year while many libraries need to keep their costs from increasing, we have developed **Standard** and **Expanded** collections to provide options for libraries.

Pricing for both collections is based on discounts from the electronic-only subscription rates for each included title. The collections are hosted by HighWire Press at **dukejournals.org**.

## STANDARD

The 2010 **e-Duke Journals Scholarly Collection: Standard** includes online access to **31** Duke humanities and social science journals: the 30 journals included in the 2009 collection plus *Nka: Journal of Contemporary African Art*. For a complete list of titles, please see page 2.

## EXPANDED

The 2010 **e-Duke Journals Scholarly Collection: Expanded** includes the 31 titles in Standard as well as *Comparative Literature*, the *Journal of Music Theory*, *Novel*, and *Philosophical Review*. The number of titles in this collection is expected to increase from year to year as Duke adds more titles.
