Euclid Prime is a collection of high-impact, peer-reviewed titles in theoretical and applied mathematics and statistics hosted by Project Euclid. The 2010 collection includes current content from 30 titles—up from 23 titles in 2009. The amount of back content accessible to current subscribers has also significantly increased, as many of the newly added titles are fully retrodigitized.
