Located on the high desert of central Oregon, the natural conditions of abundant, sunny, warm days and low humidities make Bend one of the most ideal seed extractory sites in the country. By taking advantage of these natural conditions, the Bend Seed Extractory can extract, process, package and store seed more efficiently and at lower costs.

Our facilities are capable of processing seed from both conifer and deciduous trees, as well as shrubs, forbs, grasses, and grass-like plants.



We began processing conifer seed for eastside Pacific Northwest Forests in 1978. By 1995, we were processing all plant species for all US Forest Service Pacific Northwest forests.

Today we serve the reforestation and restoration seed needs of many Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, Confederated Tribes in Oregon and Washington, Fish and Wildlife Service, State and other public land managers in the Western United States, including Alaska. Seeds collected and processed at the optimum time of maturity ensure a high germination and survival rate at planting time. These healthy seeds play an important role in reforestation, fire and road rehabilitation, streambank restoration, and the elimination of noxious weeds. The Bend Seed Extractory processes both small and large quantities of seed needed for specific applications.

Education and information gathering are important services we provide to our clients. Our staff members also focus on advancing skills and techniques in cleaning, sorting and storage, as well as performing various seed tests to improve seed quality.
