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Sidewalk Café Permit Application

Instructions

A "sidewalk café" means any area situated on a public sidewalk where food, refreshments, and/or beverages are sold by a restaurant, delicatessen, ice cream shop or coffee shop (hereinafter "operating establishment") for public consumption at tables or counters located on the sidewalk fronting the operating establishment. Sidewalk cafés shall operate only as authorized pursuant to this chapter. (Ord. O-16-99 § 1, (part); Ord. O-28-96 § 1; Ord. O-13-95 § 1 (part)).

Authority

Annapolis <u>City Code</u> and Charter, Chapter 7.42. The Code is available online or a copy will be provided to you. Please take a few minutes and review this to ensure that you are in compliance with the law. If you have any questions, please contact the Assistant City Clerk above.

To be considered complete, all license holders must submit, at the time of filing:

- 1. Effective May 1 April 30
- 2. An application, available either on the website or at the City Clerk's Office above
- 3. A sidewalk café site drawing/sketching.
- 4. A check in the amount of \$340 payable to the City of Annapolis.
- 5. An insurance certificate listing the City of Annapolis as an additional insured for the sidewalk café area.
- 6. Once approved, your sidewalk café permit will be available for you to pick up when notified.

Enforcement

§7.42.040

The provisions of this chapter shall be enforced by the Department of Public Works. A person who continues to violate this chapter after a written request to take corrective action is guilty of a municipal infraction and shall be fined for each violation as established by resolution of the City Council plus costs. In addition, the City Council may revoke or suspend a permit issued pursuant to this chapter upon a second or subsequent conviction under this section in any twelve month period. (Ord.
