Utility Connections: Before a structure is demolished, the owner or agent shall notify all utilities having utility connections within the structure such as water, electric, gas, sewer and other connections.

A permit to demolish or remove a structure shall <u>not</u> be issued until:

- A release is submitted to DNEP from the utilities company stating that their service connections and appurtenant equipment, such as meters and regulators, have been removed or sealed, and plugged in a safe manner;
- A plumbing permit is obtained from DNEP prior to demolition in order to provide properly sealed and marked sewer and water services.
