Fee

- 1. The applicant obtains an application either on the website or at the office above. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
- 2. Submit the following with the application to the office above:
 - a. A photocopy of your driver's license.
 - b. Copy of Insurance Certificate. Minimum amount: \$300,000 General Liability and \$100,000 Property Damage as per State law. CERTIFICATE HOLDER SHOULD BE THE "CITY OF ANNAPOLIS".
 - c. Copy of either:
 - i. Maryland State Master Electrical License, or
 - ii. Anne Arundel County Electrical License, or
 - iii. Electrical license from other approved jurisdiction.
 - d. License fee (see Electrical Fee Schedule), non-refundable; checks should be made payable to the City of Annapolis.
- 3. Issued licenses are not transferable for any reason.
- 4. License holders with outstanding violations will not be able to renew their license
