Tree Permit

This permit is issued by DNEP for tree removal per regulations as set forth in City Code chapter 14.12.

Property address

The tree is dead, dying or diseased, such that fifty percent or more of the crown area is visibly dead.

The tree is damaged or injured to the extent that it is likely to die or become diseased.

The removal of the tree will serve the purposes of *City Code chapter 14.12* or will enhance the health of the remaining trees in the conservation area.

The removal of the tree will avoid or alleviate, mitigate, or reduce a substantial hardship or damage to the property or any structure located hereon.

Tree species

The removal of the tree is consistent with good forestry practices.

Diameter of tree, measured at 4.5 ft above ground level

Replacement tree plantings, or a fee-in-lieu equivalent to replacement, may be required.

If your tree is located in the *Historic District*, you must show an approved tree permit to the Chief of Historic Preservation. The Historic Preservation Division of Planning & Zoning may have additional requirements. Please include a sketch illustrating where the tree(s) is located as well as the distance from the tree to the sidewalk or curb.

No machinery or work shall start prior to 7:00 a. m. and shall finish no later than dusk and there shall be no outside work on Sunday unless otherwise authorized.
