## **Application for Utility Contractor's License**

City Code Ordinance O-61-94

NOTE: Master Plumbers who hold a City of Annapolis license are **not** required to obtain this license. They are allowed to perform utility work under the City of Annapolis Master Plumber's License.

Please furnish the following: (Your application will not be processed unless all of the following information is provided.)

- 1. Copy of Insurance Certificate made out to the City of Annapolis: minimum amount of \$300,000 General Liability and \$100,000 Property Damage.
- 2. Provide copy of current Anne Arundel County Utility Contractor's License.
- 3. For new licenses, provide a letter from any other jurisdiction stating that you are in good standing with that jurisdiction. The letter must be on official letterhead of the jurisdiction. (This does NOT apply to license renewals.)
- 4. Fee is \$120.00. Checks should be made payable to City of Annapolis.
