TRICK OF THE TREAT

Objects with three dimensions – or 3D – have height, width and depth. Three-dimensional things can seem to pop out at the viewer.

We see everyday things with 3D because our eyes are about 2 to 3 inches apart. This separation causes each eye to have a slightly different view of the object. When the brain puts these views together, a 3D image with depth is formed!

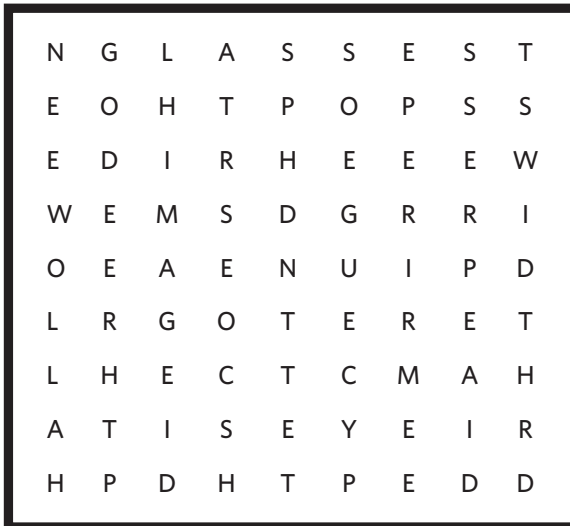
