Specifically

- Family First supports a higher priority for funding to alternative energy research and more effective strategies and technologies for treatment and recycling of waste but this needs to be balanced against the cost to the community.
- 2. Family First will support and introduce initiatives that create incentives to reduce waste and pollutants in the environment.
- 3. Family First will promote economic management that takes account of ecological impacts and places a high value on the maintenance of biodiversity and ecosystem balance. The conservation of Australia's natural resources and biodiversity are valued highly by Family First as the inheritance we are duty bound to pass on to the next generation.
