#### **DIRECTIONS**

## From Indianapolis International Airport to The Westin

Go west on I-70 West. Take IN-267 exit, EXIT 66 towards MOORESVILLE/PLAINFIELD. Take the ramp towards MOORESVILLE. Turn left onto IN-267 South. Merge onto I-70 East via the ramp on the left. Take the WEST ST. exit, EXIT 79A. Turn left onto S. MISSOURI ST./S. WEST ST. Turn right onto W. OHIO ST. Turn right onto N. CAPITOL ST. 50 S. CAPITOL ST. is on the right. Allow approximately 20-30 minutes travel time.

## From The Westin to Conseco Fieldhouse

Conseco Fieldhouse is approximately 1.16 miles from The Westin. From the hotel, start out going south on S. CAPITOL AVE. toward W. MARYLAND ST./US-40 East. Turn left onto W. MARYLAND ST./US-40 East. Turn right on S. PENNSYLVANIA ST. Conseco Fieldhouse is on the left located at 125 S. PENNSYLVANIA ST.

# **CREDENTIAL REQUEST**

Media desiring credentials to cover the NCAA Women's Final Four in Indianapolis regardless of teams must apply online (ncaa.com/media). Links to applications for all sites are available on the Web site. Institutional media should apply via their team sports information contact.

## **CREDENTIAL DISTRIBUTION**

Credentials will not be mailed. Recipients must present a government-issued photo ID and verify that they are full-time employees of the media agency. A sign-in sheet for individuals to confirm receipt of credential will be required.

Credentials will distributed at The Westin on Friday, April 1 and at Conseco Fieldhouse on Saturday, April 2 - Tuesday, April 5. All credentialed media will be permitted to enter Conseco Fieldhouse at the Delaware Street (east side) employee/media entrance. Please note that ALL bags and equipment will be searched upon entrance each day. The credential distribution schedule is listed below.

## **SATELLITE COORDINATES**

The NCAA will provide **ONLY** a High Definition (HD) 1080i feed of the news conferences, including both on-site audio/video distribution as well as satellite distribution. Stations and networks will be responsible for down-converting to Standard Definition (SD) if they are not broadcasting in HD and cross-converting to 720p if they are broadcasting in HD 720p. Any re-feed of the press conferences will be fed in SD format. Satellite coordinates will be announced at a later date.

Media, including originating radio networks, may order individual telephone and communication services, at their own expense, by contacting the NCAA Championship Telecommunications Center. Center phone number will be announced at a later date. Credentialed media will be provided complimentary wireless access codes.
