

Now truly a magical musical entity, one that's comprised of singers/songwriters/guitar-pickers Colin Brooks, Gordy Quist and Ed Jurdi, bassist Seth Whitney and drummer John Chipman. Live at Antone's, recorded in June of 2007, shows why the quintet captured 2007's "Best New Band" at the Austin Music Awards. It was the first time they ever used a set list, but like all of their shows, this performance was an exhilarating mix of familiar tunes and previously unrecorded. These percussive, atmospheric songs draw from deep roots: country, blues, gospel, jazz, New Orleans, and West African music all play a part. Passing Train includes a gorgeous but brutally stark evocation of a soldier's trial after war (Glory Days Are Gone), a riotous soul- rock anthem dedicated to novelist- prankster Ken Kesey, a lovely reflection on mortality (No One Knows How to Die), as well as a classic, grooving road song (Travel On). Several cuts feature ravishing vocal harmonies including the stirring track "Wash Away". Somehow amidst the rubble of losers, regrets, and time run away, Passing Train manages to uplift. The album moves deep into twilight but doesn't leave the listener in darkness. Harrison and his New York city mavericks create music of real emotion, lasting beauty, and visceral triumph.

Austin's Heybale present their first studio album in an eight year career; recorded as in the Nashville era when everything was tracked together with all of the musicians in one room. The core of this five piece band of legends start with Earl Poole Ball on piano who performed with The Byrds on their seminal country/rock album, Sweethearts Of The Rodeo and spent years with Johnny Cash. Redd Volkaert, once Merle Haggard's lead guitarist, plays and sings with a stark realness that permeates every song. The rhythm section is Kevin Smith on stand-up bass and Tom Lewis on drums; sought after touring musicians who've recorded with Dwight Yoakam, Brian Setzer, and others. Most of the singing and songwriting is handled by the undiscovered talent of Gary Claxton. Heybale is joined by their "Orchestra", Cindy Cashdollar, Elana James and Erik Hokkanen. 

Listen to Tin Silver and you will hear the beer halls and Baptist churches of West Texas, sun-drenched California, and a little New York thump; soaring country soul, hill blues stomp boogie, and fiddle centric folk music. The band writes collaboratively, with guitar/banjo/dobro player Alan Bowen bringing the bulk of the raw material, plus fluent bluegrass licks and blues solos. Drummer Matthew Higgins, contributes the tight bright, intricate groove he developed while cutting his teeth on Bob Wills country swing standards. Paired with Paul Prato's bottomy electric and upright bass sound and punk-bred attack, Tin Silver's rhythm section has uncommon fire and dynamic range. Tricia Rojas, the band's other Lonestar State ex-pat, brings sweet violin and the aching, rafter rattling vocals she developed singing in church choirs during her chidhood.

Scott Ellison, Ice Storm

During the 70s, Scott Ellison's home town of Tulsa, was a musical hotbed. Eric Clapton and Freddie King's bands were based there, as was Leon Russell's Shelter Records. Electrified by the British Invasion bands, moved by Motown and the soulfulness of Memphis R&B, Scott organized his first band as a youngster. In 1977, he began touring as a guitarist with Jessica James (Conway Twitty's daughter), and by 1981 "Gatemouth" Brown had tapped Scott to play rhythm in his band. By the 90s, Scott's blues band was opening for Joe Cocker, Roy Orbison, The Fabulous T-Birds, Leon Russell, Bobby Bland and Buddy Guy. Ellison's compositions have been in many TV shows and in the 2007 movie, "Feast Of Love," (Morgan Freeman).



Since cutting six well-received cds from 1988-1994 on the Ichiban label, Travis "Moonchild" Haddix has released 11 cds on his Wann-Sonn Records label. He's performed in 17 countries and is especially popular in Scandinavia and Western Europe. As a teenager in Mississippi, he drew early inspiration from listening to B.B. King on WDIA radio in Memphis. In a 2005 feature story, Living Blues Magazine had this to say about Travis: "Haddix delivers his fables of mischief, mayhem and mercy in a smooth but sinewy baritone, backed by arrangements that meld aggression with horn-leavened soul. 


