Gyeongbok-gung Palace was the main palace during the Joseon Dynasty (1392-1910) and is famous for its beautiful traditional architecture and walls. The palace was named to mean a "Palace Greatly Blessed by Heaven." The government ministry district and main buildings of the Palace formed the heart of the capital city of Seoul and represented the sovereignty of the Joseon Dynasty.

N Seoul Tower

It is the best observatory space of Seoul, where you can appreciate all the panoramic scenery of city with cutting edge media display with various cultures. N Seoul Tower, a symbol of Seoul, was established as Korea's first total electric wave tower to send TV and radio broadcasts in Seoul metropolitan area in 1969. It is the highest place in Seoul and is a resting place of Seoul citizens as well as sightseeing spot for foreign visitors.

Insa-dong

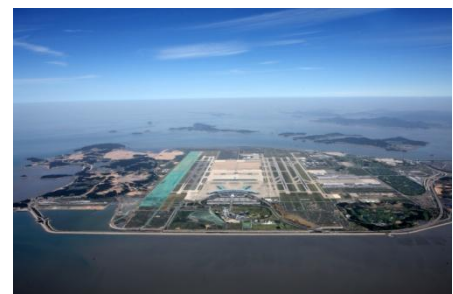
