

Pike Island Locks and Dam, Ohio River Damaged Mooring Cell at Ohio River Mile 83.2

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given the Corps of Engineer Mooring Cell, in the upper pool of Pike Island L/D, at Ohio River mile 83.2 has lost a considerable amount of fill material from inside the cell. Impacts to the cell from commercial vessels will cause loss of additional fill and could result in the eventual collapses of the cell. Commercial vessels should avoid landing on or using this mooring cell. A sign is posted on this uppermost mooring cell warning boats to stay clear.
2. There are two remaining mooring cells in the Pike Island upper lock approach at Ohio River Mile 83.5 and 83.6 that are available for mooring commercial vessels.
