<u>Demolition of Span 6 &7 of the Charleroi-Monessen Bridge</u> <u>Monongahela River, Main channel, Mile 41.03</u>

- 1. <u>To All Whom It May Concern:</u> Notice is given that Joseph B. Fay Company will be demolishing span 6 & 7 of the Charleroi-Monessen Bridge over the Monongahela River, river mile 41.03, in North Charleroi, Pennsylvania.
- 2. The work is scheduled to begin on Monday July 11, 2011 and the approximate date of completion is July 13, 2011. Spans 6 & 7 will be demolished simultaneously. The navigation span (Span 7) shall be removed from the river channel and opened with 24 hours of the demolition. Span 6 removal shall commence immediately after the complete removal of Span 7. A total of 48 hours will be allowed for the complete removal of structure.

Please note, the contractor will continue to work within the area Monday through Friday and select Saturdays, 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., beginning July 11, 2011 and ending November 2012. An additional notice pertaining to the reconstruction of the new bridge will be issued at a later date.

- 3. Tug boats along with a floating crane barge and multiple deck barges will be used during the work activity.
- 4. Mariners should monitor radio frequency channels 13, 16, and 68 while transiting in the vicinity of the construction site.
- 5. Navigators, please note the location and duration of this work and use caution in and around the area.
