Dewater 56' x 360' Auxiliary Lock and Install Lock, Dam, and Waterway Signs

- 1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Repair Fleet will close and dewater the small 56' x 360' lock chamber to perform repairs to all four gates, gate anchorages, and miter sills. Also, new signage will be installed during this time period on the locks walls, dam abutment, and mooring cells. The repair work is scheduled to begin at 1:00 AM on July 5, 2011 and will be completed by 11:00 PM on August 11, 2011.
- 2. The 56' x 360' river chamber will be closed to navigation during this work period. The 110' x 600' land chamber will remain open to all navigation during this work period. Minor delays to navigation are expected.

The mooring cells will not be available while the Repair Fleet is installing new signs on the cells. Check with Dashields Locks to determine the current available of the mooring cells.

Mooring Cell #1 is located at River Mile 12.3 on left bank, Mooring Cell #2 is located at River Mile 12.7 on left bank, Mooring Cell #3 is located at River Mile 14.2 on right bank.

- 3. General wear and deterioration of the gates, gate anchorages, and miter sills has made it necessary to schedule this work.
- 4. Navigators please note the location and duration of this work and use caution when entering or leaving the land chamber.
