L/D 3, Monongahela River, Mile 23.8
Land Chamber and River Chamber Shutdowns
to Replace Hydraulic Pipe

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will replace hydraulic pipe that control the operating machinery for both the land and river lock chambers at L/D 3, Monongahela River, Mile 23.8. Work is scheduled from November 7-23, 2011. The River Chamber will be closed for the entire work period and there will also be numerous 16-hour closures of the Land Chamber. The Land Chamber closures will be from 8:00 A.M to 12:00 midnight on the following dates: November 8, 9, 10, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 21, and 22.
2. **No traffic will pass through the 56'x 360' river lock chamber during the work period November 7-23, 2011. No traffic will pass through the 56' x 720' land lock chamber during the 16-hour shutdowns dates indicated above.** There will be times during the scheduled 16-hour closures that the repair efforts will not require the land lock chamber to be closed. Vessels should contact Lock 3, Monongahela by marine radio or phone 412-384-4532 to get the operational status.
3. Severe deterioration of the hydraulic pipe that controls the operating machinery has made it necessary to schedule this work.
