**Lock 4, Allegheny River, Mile 24.2**  
**Repairs to the Downstream Miter Gates**

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Repair Fleet will be working in the single 56' x 360' lock chamber at Lock 4, Allegheny River, Mile 24.2 to make repairs to the downstream miter gate. The Repair Fleet working will be in the chamber December 6, 7, and 8 from 4:00 PM thru 8:00 AM. The work will be completed by December 9 at 8:00 AM.
2. The large 56' x 360' lock chamber will be closed during the work period, but we can pass commercial traffic.
3. This repair is necessary because of a navigation accident.
