New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River, Mile 54.4 24-Hour Closure of the Large 110' x 1200' Lock Chamber to Repair Miter Gate Operating Machinery

- 1. To All Whom It May Concern: Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' will repair miter gate operating machinery in the 110' x 1200' river lock chamber at New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River. The work is scheduled to begin at 08:00 A.M., August 16, 2011 and should be completed by 08:00 A.M., August 17, 2011.
- 2. The <u>large 110' x 1200' lock chamber will be closed</u> during the 24-hour work period. The small 110' X 600' lock chamber will be open. Tow haulage winches will not be available, but a double lockage will be accepted if "industry self-help" is available.
- 3. This closure is necessary to replace broken parts as soon as possible to prevent more serious damage to the miter gate operating equipment in the future.
- 4. Navigators should use caution while entering or leaving the land lock chamber.
