**New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River, Mile 54.4**  
**24-Hour Closure of the Large 110' x 1200' Lock Chamber**  
**to Repair Miter Gate Operating Machinery**

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' will repair miter gate operating machinery in the 110' x 1200' river lock chamber at New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River. The work is scheduled to begin at 08:00 A.M., August 16, 2011 and should be completed by 08:00 A.M., August 17, 2011.
2. The **large 110' x 1200' lock chamber will be closed** during the 24-hour work period. The small 110' X 600' lock chamber will be open. Tow haulage winches will not be available, but a double lockage will be accepted if "industry self-help" is available.
3. This closure is necessary to replace broken parts as soon as possible to prevent more serious damage to the miter gate operating equipment in the future.
4. Navigators should use caution while entering or leaving the land lock chamber.
