Installation of Pipeline Crossing Monongahela River, Mile 34.6

1. **TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that Michels Pipeline Construction, a contractor for Dominion Transmission (DTI) will install the Appalachian Gateway pipeline crossing on the Monongahela River at mile 34.6 near Donora, in Washington County, Pennsylvania.
2. **Partial navigation channel closures are expected, but there will not be full navigation channel closures due to pipeline construction. Work will continue until December 12, 2011. Michels will be working 7:00 am – 5:00 pm, 6 days/week. The work was initially proposed to start the week of September 12th and continue intermittently throughout November 11th. Project delays have occurred due to the weather and administrative items in permitting of the work site which will require extending the work period for 30 days.**
3. During this work, the M/V Jesse Z (or other Ohio River Salvage Towboat), a derrick boat, and deck barge will be on site.
4. Navigators, please note the location and duration of this work and use caution in and around the area. During Non-working hours, the floating plant will be moored at the work site clear of the navigation channel and lighted according to regulations.
5. Mariners should monitor radio marine channels 13 and 16 while in the vicinity of the pipeline crossing site.
