Work to begin next week on the State Route 2025 Garrett's Run Road Cochran's Mills Bridge #1 Project in Armstrong County

Indiana – PennDOT Engineering District 10 is advising motorists that work will begin next week on the State Route (SR) 2025, Garrett's Run Road Cochran's Mills Bridge #1 replacement project. The project is located on SR 2025, Garrett's Run Road over Crooked Creek in Burrell Township, Armstrong County.

Beginning, Monday, May 2, 2011, daylight flagger controlled traffic restrictions will occur on SR 2025, Garrett's Run Road, to prepare for the May 2, 2011 road closure and detour. Initial work will include building the access road, excavating, and moving utilities.

On May 2, 2001, SR 2025 will close and a detour will be in place. The road will remain closed for the duration of the project.

The detour will begin at the SR 2025 (Garrett's Run Road) and SR 2026 (Cochran's Mills Road) intersection to SR 2027 (Girty Road) near Girty to SR 422 in Elderton to SR 2005 (Cherry Run Road) at the Margret intersection to Brick Church to SR 2025 (Garrett's Run Road).

Work on this \$3,899,498 bridge replacement project will be completed by The Velotta Company of Sharon Center, Ohio. The project is expected to be completed at the end of September 2011.
