Based on information we received from your organization it has come to our attention that the pavilion at Hogan's Fountain is currently undergoing what you referenced as 'demolition by neglect' and needs an organization such as yours to champion the funding for its restoration and continued upkeep. We applaud your efforts on that front. As the local American Institute of Architects, we recognize the importance of preserving the character and historic fabric of the structures that help define the beautiful Olmstead parks in Louisville.
