The longest Torch Relay in Olympic history will travel on over 50 different modes of transport, including a giant jet, a prime mover a fleet of buses, and Harley-Davidson motorcycles. A scuba diver has carried it underwater at the Great Barrier Reef and it will visit a bungy jump site!

The Sydney 2000 Olympic Torch draws its inspiration from the Sydney Opera House, and the subtle curve of the boomerang.
