## → About **Eutelsat**












#### THE EUTELSAT SATELLITE SYSTEM

- Audience of over 200 million cable and satellite TV homes
- Teleports in France and Italy providing broadband services throughout the Eutelsat coverage zone, on land, in flight and at sea
- Workforce of 700 men and women of 30 nationalities
- Consolidated revenues: €1 168 million financial year 2010-2011 (+11.5%)
