Closure of Shoreditch Station

The closure of Shoreditch station is essential to advanced works being undertaken for the extension of the East London Line. The station at Pedley Street which currently opens only for peak time travel, will be replaced in 2010 by Shoreditch High Street Station on the site of the old Bishopsgate Goods Yard. The new station will be open full time and run a full operational service north to Dalston Junction and south to New Cross, Crystal Palace and West Croydon.



The streets around Shoreditch Station are narrow,

therefore it will not be possible for the bus service to run from the station. The bus will instead pick up and drop off on Bethnal Green Road and pick up and drop off at Whitechapel Road

outside Whitechapel Station.

In addition to the replacement bus service, Brick Lane is a 10-15 minute walk from Liverpool Street. Bus routes 8 and 388 also run to and from Bethnal Green Road.

Alternatively, Aldgate East is approximately 10 minutes walk to and from Shoreditch via Osborne Street and Brick Lane. The east-end entrance to Aldgate East station is now open full time, making access to and from the area and Brick Lane market much easier.

Shoreditch Station - Replacement Bus Service

Please be aware that Shoreditch Station will be permanently closed from 9th June 2006. However, from Sunday 11 June 2006 a rail replacement bus service will be in operation.

Six buses per hour will run in each direction between Shoreditch and Whitechapel, with a journey time of approximately 6-8 minutes. The service will operate at the same times as the trains serving Shoreditch Station.
