2012 NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

32nd ANNUAL NCAA FIELD HOCKEY CHAMPIONSHIP

The winner of the BIG EAST Championship receives the league's automatic bid to the 32nd annual, 16-team, NCAA Division I Field Hockey Championship. The first two rounds are held on the campuses of participating institutions in a single-elimination format. The 2012 Field Hockey Championship will be hosted by Old Dominion University in Norfolk, Va., Nov. 16 and 18. The BIG EAST has claimed two national titles, both by Connecticut, in 1981 and 1985. In 2012, Connecticut earned the BIG EAST's automatic bid and Syracuse received an at-large bid.

Offensive Player of the Year

Marie Elena Bolles, Connecticut, Jr., F



The 2012 Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, Bolles ranks third in the league in points with 28. She averaged 1.56 points per game and scored 11 goals in the regular season. The junior scored five gamewinning goals, for the Huskies this year and three against ranked opponents. Her efforts on offense kept the Huskies undefeated through 16 games this season, the longest undefeated streak of

Defensive Player of the Year

Iona Holloway, Syracuse, Sr., B



Holloway led a defensive line that posted eight shutouts and allowed just 15 goals all season. The Orange rank No. 1 in the nation in goals against average at 0.81 per game. The Syracuse defense allowed six goals and posted three shutouts in league play en route to a 6-0 record and the regular season title. The Orange ceded just 39 penalty corners to ranked opponents, an average of 4.88 per game.

Rookie of the Year

Alyssa Bull, Rutgers, Fr., M



Bull is tied as the second leading scorer for the Scarlet Knights with five goals and six assists. The freshman also is in a three-way tie for first in league play defensive saves with 2. Bull recorded two of her five goals against ranked opponents (No. 19 Albany on Aug. 24 and No. 6 Maryland on Oct. 26). Bull also scored two goals in a league game against Georgetown on Oct. 5.

Coaching Staff of the Year

Ange Bradley, Syracuse



Coach Bradley was named 2012 BIG EAST Field Hockey Coach of the Year after leading the Orange to an NFCA Coaches Poll No. 1 ranking for two weeks the regular season season. It was the first time the Orange have been ranked No. 1 since making a national semifinal run in 2008. Bradley led The Orange to the BIG EAST regular season title and the No. 1 seed in the 2012 BIG EAST Championship.
