# Looking ahead to... IAAF Council Meeting in Kiev

Following its last meeting which took place in Doha, Qatar in the days after the World Indoor Championships, the <u>IAAF Council</u>, the body which administers the affairs of the International Association of Athletics Federations, next month will hold its second meeting of 2010. Headed by President Lamine Diack, Council Members will gather in the Ukrainian capital of Kiev, the home city of Senior Vice-President Sergey Bubka, for two day's of discussions (Sat 7 and Sun 8 Aug).

Kiev's Hyatt Regency Hotel will be the venue for the IAAF Council, and in the course of two preceding days will also host meetings of the Sustainable Development Commission, Fair Play Working Group, Athletics World Plan Steering Board, and Executive Board.
