King of Rangitoto \$20.00 to \$40.00 Entry fee depending upon discipline

The Whangamata Classic (NR/ER carnival) \$12.00 Entry fee

NR Champs (NRC's) \$50.00 Entry fee

NR Junior Champs \$40.00 Entry fee

The increases in cost are as a result of general event cost rises and higher event safety standards. All other Surf Life Saving Northern Region Surf Sports events will remain free of any entry costs.
