

2011 AWOL Three Race Series Announcing our Classic Race Format Plus Other Updates and Changes Making 2011 our "Best Year Yet"

All Series races are released within a **Federation release of up to 2800 birds**. Because the race loft is located on the extreme long end of the Federation, race birds come in singles not in drops. From 2007 through 2010, the average time TO WIN between the first and second race birds was 6 minutes, this means there are no clocking duels and the winning birds have distanced themselves from the competition.

Entry fees:

\$200 for your primary bird (send as many backup birds as you want)

Perch Fees:

1-5 birds $\sim 90 per bird (including Back Up birds) 6 or more $\sim 80 per bird (including Back Up birds)

Race Schedule

 $09/25/2011\sim 220$ Miles for Average Speed Only $10/08/2011\sim 300$ Miles for 20% of Capital Prizes + Average Speed $10/22/2011\sim 350$ Miles for 50% of Capital Prizes + Average Speed

Payouts

70% of entry fees to be paid out in Capital Prizes 30% of entry fees to be paid out in Average Speed Prizes

Activation Policy

All birds will be trained on the federation training truck out to 137 miles
Breeder will receive an inventory of all their birds after the 137 mile trainer
Breeder will have until the date listed on the inventory sheet to activate all of their remaining birds

All birds that remain unactivated, become the property of the AWOL race They will be shipped to the 220 and 300 races but their results will not be posted

Unactivated birds may be activated by any fancier on the night of shipping the 350 mile race Ownership of the bird transfers with the activation

The AWOL race will take a 15% cut from these new activation fees with the remainder distributed 70% going into capital prizes for the 350 Mile Race 30% going into capital prizes for Average Speed

Birds activated for the 350 mile race, are only eligible for Capital prizes on the 350 mile race They are not eligible for Average Speed Payouts

The AWOL is a unique race series which allows you to test your birds against the toughest competition, within a large federation release, where quality birds can show their stuff, competing in three races (870 miles) over a four week period.
