Move to conditionally approve the P1680.1 PAR for revision of a standard until December 2016, contingent upon the receipt of a favorable review of the WG P&Ps by AudCom.

"IEEE-SA Standards Board Operations Manual

5.4.3.1 Ballot term

Each ballot in the standards balloting process shall close at 11:59 p.m. ET on the closing date specified on the ballot. The length of the ballot and associated recirculations is set by the Sponsor. The initial ballot term shall be at least 30 days in duration. The recirculation ballot term shall be at least 10 days in duration.

The Sponsor shall assess the return rate of the first ballot, where the return is the ratio of the sum of Sponsor balloting group members' *Approve*, *Do Not Approve*, and *Abstain* votes to the count of Sponsor balloting group members.

In the first ballot, if the ballot has not achieved a 75% return by the specified closing date, the ballot may be extended to close when a 75% return is received. This extension for receipt of a 75% return shall not be longer than 60 days.

Summary: This change defines the minimum durations for initial and recirculation ballots."

There was no opposition to the motion, and the motion was approved.

Steve reported that the IEEE-SA is working with other SDOs to align strategic objectives. He was invited to Geneva (ISOC eNet Conference; ITU-T workshop on eHealth). Steve will be discussing alignment with ISOC/IETF/W3C at the BOG meeting on 14 June.

Steve gave an update on the hiring process for the incoming IEEE-SA Managing Director. The process is in the final stages and it is expected that the new Managing Director will be on board by mid-August.

9.2 SASB Chair's Report

Chair Hulett gave a verbal update.

Chair Hulett noted that the IEEE owns a representative to the U.S. Election Assistance Commission Technical Guidelines Development Committee (TGDC). Chair Hulett noted that an ad hoc group (Rich Hulett [Chair], John Kulick, Susan Tatiner, Dave Ringle, and Tricia Gerdon) are in the process of reviewing candidates for the currently vacant IEEE seat. In addition, the ad hoc is exploring how to transfer OBC responsibility from the SASB to a standards Sponsor.

Chair Hulett noted that ICCom held a meeting this morning. At future SASB meeting series, it is expected that ICCom will meet on Day 1 of the series, probably in the late afternoon (after PatCom).
