Check-in/Paperwork

Each team will be required to check-in at the headquarters tent one hour before their first game. Teams in the 96, 97 and 98 brackets must bring with them 10 player rosters, which include first and last name, jersey number and date of birth. If you plan on making rosters available for college coaches, I would look to bring more than 10 rosters and I would look to include email addresses and phone numbers. Those teams in the 99 and 00 brackets only need to bring 10 rosters. Any player who would like to bring a player profile for the college coaches' tent, is welcome to do so.

All rosters must be typed and signed by the Club Director (we have included a template for those who would like to use this). Each team participating must bring with them a version of their medical release form (medical release form or player card work) and a Player Code of Conduct form (your version). Each team will need to keep at least 4 rosters for themselves in order to give one to the referee before each game.
