Guidelines for Reviewers

The Journal relies profoundly on researchers, educators and scientists to review manuscripts submitted for publication. The journal adjudicator system is an important mean for maintaining the quality of the proficient and scientific literature. Reviewers can contribute to the journal in a better way if they know what editors expect of them. Moreover, authors and readers of articles should be aware of the care that is taken in selecting papers for publication.

Manuscripts are first read by the editors. Manuscripts outside the scope of the Journal or those of only marginal interest to begin with and further disgraced by poor writing are rejected without further review. Brief reports on practice innovations are accepted without outside review. If a manuscript has an evident deficiency, we may ask the author to amend it before forwarding it to reviewers. Most of the manuscripts received, however, are sent to outside reviewers straight after staff review. Staff comments are sent to the author later with the reviewers' critiques.

One or two reviewers are selected, depending upon their credentials and our confidence in their aptitude to evaluate the manuscripts.

Identification of authors and their work affiliations are removed from a manuscript before sending it to reviewers. Reviewers' comments are sent anonymously to authors to reduce the bias in review process and to encourage reviewers to give honest judgment.
