





HOUSING

The area's main housing types are semi detached and terraced, equalling over 67% of the housing stock between them. Detached is the next largest proportion, which is bigger than flat, mainsonette or apartment by almost 3.5%. The ward consists of 183 local authority owned properties and 176 Housing Association properties.



SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Carmarthen Town West, based on CACI's 2011 'PayCheck' data, is £25,601 which is the 14^{th} highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 12.2% below the Carmarthenshire mean of £29,156.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a slightly higher level of people in supervisory, clerical, junior managerial/professional employment (grade C1) and a lower than the county average of skilled manual workers (grade C2).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2011 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The
WIMD 2011 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education,
Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is
published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire.
Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, Carmarthen Town West 1 ranks 42
out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 727 in Wales from 1896 LSOAs.
Carmarthen Town West 2 is ranked 102 in Carmarthenshire and 1416 in Wales whilst
Carmarthen Town West 3 ranks as 77 in Carmarthenshire and 1105 in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Carmarthen Town West 1** is the Physical Environment domain, being ranked 11th in Carmarthenshire and 188th in Wales for this domain. The Physical Environment is also the highest ranking domain In **Carmarthen Town West 2** being ranked 19th in Carmarthenshire and 310 in Wales. This Physical Environment domain is also the highest ranking in **Carmarthen Town West 3** ranking 18th in Carmarthenshire and 300 in Wales.
