





#### HOUSING

The area's housing consists mainly of detached houses, which has a larger proportion then the other categories combined. Semi-detached hold the next highest proportion, followed by terraced. # SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Cenarth based on CACI's 2011 'PayCheck' data, is £21,286 which is the 9<sup>th</sup> lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 27% below the Carmarthenshire mean of £29,156.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people classed as skilled manual workers (grade C2) and a lower than average semiskilled and unskilled manual workers (grade D).

# WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2011 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2011 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Cenarth** ranks 35 out of 112 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 683 in Wales from 1896 LSOAs.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Cenarth** is the Housing domain, being ranked 9<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 480<sup>th</sup> in Wales for this domain.
