





HOUSING



SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Glanamman, based on CACI's 2011 'PayCheck' data, is £24,381 which is the 27th highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 16.4% below the Carmarthenshire mean of £29,156.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people on state benefit, unemployment or low grade workers (grade E) and a higher than average semi-skilled and unskilled manual workers (grade D).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2011 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2011 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived **Glanamman 1** ranks 24 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 556 in Wales from 1896 LSOAs. **Glanamman 2** ranks 33 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 676 from in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Glanamman 1** is the Health domain, being ranked 17th in Carmarthenshire and 387th in Wales for this domain. In **Glanamman 2** the Employment domain is the most prominent ranking 22nd in Carmarthenshire and 400 in Wales.
