



### HOUSING

The area's housing consists mainly of detached and semi-detached accommodation, which are almost equal in their proportions. Cumulatively they equal almost 81% of the housing stock. The smallest proportion is attributed to the flat, maisonette or apartment category. The ward consists of 124 local authority owned properties and 35 Housing Association properties.



# SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Hendy, based on CACI's 2011 'PayCheck' data, is £30,321 which is the  $2^{nd}$  highest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 4% above the Carmarthenshire mean of £29,156.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people in higher and intermediate managerial/professional (grade AB) and a lower than average on state benefit, unemployed or low grade workers (grade E).

# WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2011 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2011 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Hendy 1** ranks 110 out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1675 in Wales from 1896 LSOAs. **Hendy 2** ranks 93 in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 1242 from 1896 LSOAs in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Hendy 1** is the Access to Services domain, being ranked 54<sup>th</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 489<sup>th</sup> in Wales for this domain. In **Hendy 2** the Community Safety domain is the most prominent ranking 53<sup>rd</sup> in Carmarthenshire and 1329 in Wales.
