







SOCIO-ECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

- ⇒ The estimated median household income for Kidwelly, based on CACI's 2011 'PayCheck' data, is £22,818 which is the 18th lowest (of 58 wards) in Carmarthenshire and 21.7% below the Carmarthenshire mean of £29,156.
- ⇒ The social profile information indicates a higher than average level of people on state benefit, unemployed or low grade workers (grade E) and a higher than average semi-skilled and unskilled manual workers (grade D).

WELSH INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION (WIMD)

WIMD 2011 based on fine-grained geography of lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs). The WIMD 2011 is compiled from eight domains, Income, Employment, Health, Education, Housing, Access to Services, Physical Environment and Community Safety and is published at Lower Super Output Area of which there are 112 in Carmarthenshire. Under WIMD, where Rank 1 is the most deprived, **Kidwelly 1** ranks as the 20th most deprived area out of 112 LSOAs in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 531 in Wales from 1896 LSOAs. **Kidwelly 2** ranks 59th in Carmarthenshire and is ranked 928 from 1896 LSOAs in Wales.

The highest level of deprivation attributed to **Kidwelly 1** is the Education domain, being ranked 10th in Carmarthenshire and 381 in Wales for this domain. In **Kidwelly 2** the Employment domain is the most prominent ranking 46th in Carmarthenshire and 708th in Wales.
