The Standing Senate Committee on Transport and Communications is beginning a study of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation. On May 21, 2013, the Committee received the following Order of Reference:

That the Standing Senate Committee on Transport and Communications be authorized to examine and report on the challenges faced by the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation in the context of the complex and changing broadcasting and communications landscape.

That the committee report to the Senate from time to time, with a final report no later than October 31, 2014 and that the committee retain all powers necessary to publicize its findings until 180 days after the tabling of the final report.
